This website contains a set of nine articles that were **produced** as part of the National Quality Council project on employability skills and authored by project consultant Dr John Mitchell.

The **aim** of the articles is to promote effective approaches to assessing and reporting employability skills, following the embedding of employability skills in Training Packages.

The articles **provide** concrete exemplars of how trainers/assessors are effectively responding to the inclusion of employability skills in Training Packages, relating these responses to the model for assessing and reporting employability skills.

Permission was given by the people profiled in the articles to use the articles for professional development and promotional purposes related to employability skills.

The articles can be used by VET bodies to promote good practice in the assessing and reporting employability skills. It is expected that the articles could be used as part of professional development programs. The articles could also be made available for practitioners to access when they wish.
